Established as a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization with the purpose of implementing community service programs, providing scholarships and funding charitable donations to other not-for-profits, our programs target six areas of need and include: Youth Enrichment (especially girls), Health and Wellness, Global Poverty, Economic Security, Social Justice and Human Rights.



Our Impact

We have contributed more than \$1.5 million in programs, college scholarships, and not-for-profit donations. We work to combat and address many challenges underserved and under-resourced communities face through our program focus. We have been successful because of our partnerships, collaborations and efforts to support local businesses, civic and social organizations. Through programs, donations and partnerships, we are positively impacting the neighborhoods where our members live and work.

- \$50,000 awarded in College Scholarships in 2024
 - 6 to high school graduates
 - 4 to current college students
- 2,500 families served in 2024 via World Vision donations via partnerships with United African Organization, Olive Branch Mission, The Southwest Collective, The Montessori School of Englewood, MontClare Seniors of Englewood, Margaret's Village, Rosenwald Court Apartments, and Family Rescue Centers.
- Collected over 3,000 pieces of Women's Essentials (underwear) to donate to Giving Others Dreams for justice impacted women

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- 1,750 food baskets were donated during the 20th Annual Community Feeding-- 8,000 families served and 9 agencies involved in distributing the food baskets.
- 3,000 backpacks distributed from August 2024–October 2024 to the Montessori School of Englewood, Beautiful Zion M.B.Church, Trinity Urban Ministries, Urban Outreach Ministries, The Southwest Collective, Park Manor Christian Church, and Delta Phi Delta Dance Fraternity. 3,000 Childhood Hunger Initiative Power Packs (CHIPP) distributed to students at Paul Cuffe STEM Academy to combat childhood hunger and help alleviate food insecurity.
- “Supporting Our Sisters” program held at Family Rescue Mission; provided Easter Baskets to 20 children and provided support to 12 domestic violence impacted mothers.
- Spring EggStravaganza held at Kennicott Park District; over 150 guests attended. 50 Easter baskets were distributed to children.
- Participated in the Southside Community Baby Shower sponsored by Illinois Senator Tammy Duckworth; 18,000 diapers distributed through a partnership with Share Our Spare and donation from Cradles to Crayons.
- 528 attended the 18th Community Expo featuring the 34th Annual Music and Arts Explosion held at the
- Montessori School of Englewood. 185 students at the Montessori School of Englewood received underwear/undergarments and other hygiene essentials to start the 2024–2025 school year.
- Three teen Mental Health Forums were held—two during Mental Health Awareness month in May and one at Englewood STEM High School. Over 250 youth attended the three mental health forums.
- 300 Winter Coats were donated to children (infant to 13) at The Montessori School of Englewood.
- 500 Seasonal Wraps were donated in November to various organizations including the The Montessori School of Englewood, MontClare Seniors of Englewood, Englewood residents, Olive Branch Mission and Maria’s Shelter.
- 500 Adult Personal Hygiene Kits were donated to Olive Branch Mission, Maria’s Shelter and District 006 and 007 police departments.
- Provided 350 holiday gifts to children and families at Olive Branch Mission, Maria’s Shelter and Englewood residents in partnership with Beautiful Zion M.B. Church.
- Supported 23 high school girls via our teen mentoring program.

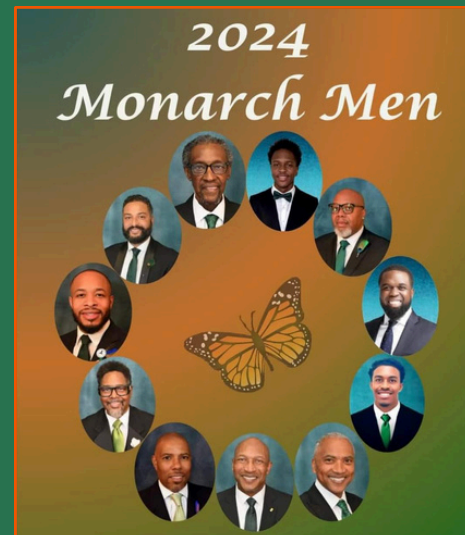


Annual Community Feeding
